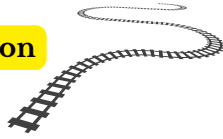

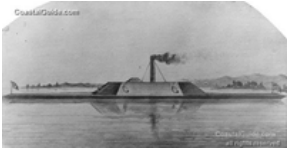


1. In what city do the Atlantic and North Carolina Railroad and Wilmington and Weldon Railroad meet?

Hint: Where do the two points on the map intersect?

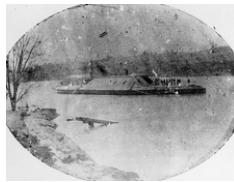


2. Which ironclad was not built in North Carolina?
